As part of his Fellowship, Dr. Vox was a research collaborator with Dr. Douglas Katz, Medical Director of the Braintree Rehabilitation Hospital, Acquired Brain Injury Program. Dr. Vox also serves as Clinical Assistant Professor at Tufts University School of Medicine in the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

The addition of Dr. Vox marks the latest milestone of New England Rehabilitation Hospital's plan to expand service capabilities into specialized areas to treat more complicated cases and attain prestigious Disease-Specific Certification in Brain Injury Rehabilitation from The Joint Commission. To support this effort, the hospital recently completed a renovation program to create a unit of 15 private rooms tailored to the specific needs of this patient population.
